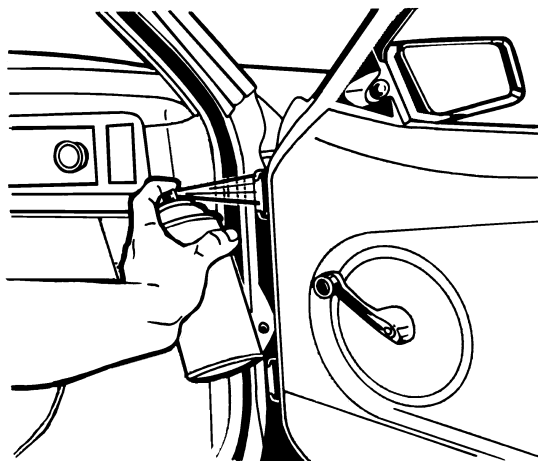

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

1. Provide adequate ventilation.
2. Shake can thoroughly before use. Note: There is no ball agitator inside the can. For best results, aerosol can should be at room temperature before spraying.
3. Holding can 8 to 10 inches from the surface for open area lubrication, or 5 inches using the extension tube provided for hard to reach areas, press the nozzle and discharge the product on the assembly.
